

Receipts

November's receipts were \$10,800 lower than October's. The majority of this difference is because we received a \$9,900 "catch-up" payment for one household's pledge in October. The remainder of the difference is small timing differences in members' contributions.

Disbursements

Disbursements in November were \$3,250 higher than in October mostly for property-related expenses: October and November cleaning bills were paid in November (\$1,300), maintenance expenses for the inside fire sprinkler (\$700), boiler repairs (\$400), and higher heating costs (\$700).




