- Council will be working on clarifying our mission and goals before we go further with the call committee.

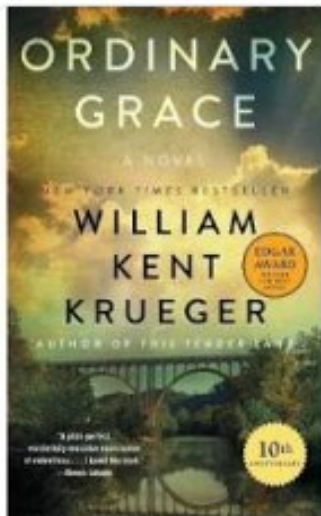
February 22, 2024 Council Meeting Summary

Comments - January

- January's surplus was \$30,000, but this was a one time experience which isn't expected to recur for the rest of the year. Contributions were \$22,000 higher than December, but one-time contributions (where members pay at least one-half of their annual pledge) accounted for \$22,000 of the receipts. Rents were down about \$1,000 because users paid rents from previous months in December.
- On the expense side, most categories were lower in January because of extra, scheduled year-end payments made in December. But the most significant expense savings in January was because we didn't have a full time pastor in place. As a result, we saved over \$10,000. Beginning February 1, we have a full time interim pastor, so we won't see this level of savings going forward.
- The bottom line is, although January was a very positive month financially, we remain on track for a significant deficit by the end of the year.
